



PRACTICAL RECYCLING GUIDE



Type of Material

How to get it ready?

Do not include

Aluminum

Aluminum cans: soft drinks, juices, beer, other.

Plastic

All detergent, oil, shampoo bottle types and sizes and any other plastic product such as: chairs or tableware (Plastic N° 4, 5, 6 y 7).

Paper or cardboard

Newspaper, magazines, phonebooks, white and colored paper, shredded paper and cardboard. Paper bags and boxes.

Glass

Bottles and container of every color and shape, glass tableware.

Tetra Pak

Milk, juice, beverage boxes, among others.

Rinse and drain.

Rinse and drain. The plastic must be clean and free of oil.

Paper and cardboard boxes must be disassembled and placed in a plastic bag.

Rinse and drain.

Completely open one side of the container, rinse and drain and compact.

Do not include cans of paint or spray cans.

PVC products, plastic bags, snack wrappers should not be included.

Paper or cardboard with food or grease residue or wet; toilet paper, sanitary napkins, diapers, napkins, disposable products and polystyrene. Paper type: thermal, carbon, chemical, parchment, waxed and cellophane paper.

No not mix bottles with other types of glass such as glass from windows, mirrors, tableware crystal, Pyrex and safety glass.

All types of Tetra Paks are recyclable.
